I was trained in fashion design at Los Angeles Trade Tech. and Advertising Illustration at the Los Angeles Art Center College of Design. I was also given private lessons in creating Supergraphics and sign painting at various sign shops in New York and Ventura California. I have owned my own Supergraphic and sign business in Los Angeles as well as upstate New York throughout my career as an artist. I was hired to design a series of characters and illustrations in the 70's. These images were then put onto tote bags, pillows, quilts, shoe bags and t-shirts and sold nationally via the finest department stores.

In the 90's I was hired to create a theme for the Ventura Harbor Village in Ventura California and to choose the colors for the buildings...a public commission.

I have written and illustrated 4 children's books I call Bunky Books, created several series of fine art paintings, painted murals, signs and designed graphic art for many clients over the past several decades.

I have also painted several series of paintings in various mediums throughout her career. One of my latest series is what I call my decade series. I have completed 6 decade paintings of the first half of the 20^{th} Century depicting popular American culture. Each one is painted with oil paints on Masonite board. Originals measure 4' x 6'. They take between 4 & 6 months to finish.

My work is currently displayed at the Art Avenue Galleries, Artfinity in Sarasota Florida. Exhibition have been in New York and Oregon also.

I raised 2 children and has 2 grandchildren. I was born and raised in West Los Angeles. I love to dance, sing, draw, paint, design, write, play piano, illustrate stories, garden and commune with nature.

I get inspiration from many different artists and life itself. I started meditating in 1967 with the Maharishi and in 1976 I aligned with Self Realization Fellowship and Yogananda.
